

Inaugural concert of the « Nationalsozialistischen ReichsSymphonieorchester » at Circus Krone

Sunday, 10 January 1932 :

After a long period of preparation, inaugural concert of the « Nationalsozialistischen ReichsSymphonieorchester » (originally consisting of 72 musicians) under the baton of Franz Adam at Munich's Nazi sanctuary, « Zirkus Kröne », in front of more than 8,000 spectators. A real triumph !!!

Carl Maria von Weber : Overture to « Oberon », Romantic Opera in 3 Acts.

Richard Wagner : Prelude to Act 1 from « Die Meistersinger von Nürnberg » (WWV 96) .

Anton Bruckner : Symphony No. 4 in E-flat major, « Romantic » (WAB 104) .
